


Types of Dashboards to meet your needs



People, Process, Technology, and Data


- We're leveraging Sage Intacct to optimize our Business Processes and gain efficiencies.

Types of Dashboards

Dashboards can break down complex data, help track business segments, encourage team collaboration, provide drill down into source transactions, and streamline business intelligence and reporting.







Dashboard Type: Strategic

Provides strategic guidance, based on snapshots of the data. They can align business segment performance with overall company strategy.

Strategic dashboards typically include:

Key Performance Indicators

Comparative Data

Performance Tracking

Data from Multiple Sources

Examples of Strategic dashboards: Management Strategic Dashboard, CFO Dashboard for Strategic Planning





Dashboard Type: Analytical

Hands-on dashboards for your managers and data analysts. Allowing you to identify trends to help you make decisions about the future.

Analytical dashboards typically include:

Interactive Components

Vast amount of data

Comparative Data

Filterable Components

Examples of Analytical Dashboards: Financial performance, Procurement costs






Dashboard Type: Operational

Monitoring dashboards that provide a glimpse into the day-to-day activities of your business. This is the most common type of dashboard.

Operational dashboards typically include:



Examples of Operational Dashboards: Controller, AR Manager, AP Manager, Grant Manager





Dashboard Type: Tactical

Help analysts and line-of-business managers analyze historical data and visualize trends to gain deeper understanding.



Building Blocks: Performance Cards



Single value component that represents an account group comparison against a period, budget, or computation. For example, Debt to Equity Ratio, Net Income and Revenue vs. Plan.





Building Blocks: Reports

Financial and memorized reports to display as a live report or as a snapshot.



Building Blocks: Charts & Graphs


Variations of pie, column, bar, area, and line charts. For example, stacked column, Stacked bar, Doughnut.





Building Blocks: Records (Queries, Lists, Ect.)

Filter and sort transaction and data records for action, approvals, or monitoring. For example, Bills, Invoices, Posted Payments.








Building Blocks: General


Shortcuts and productivity tools to stay informed, improve navigation, efficiency and oversight. For example, Close Thru Summary, Billboard, Main shortcuts, Custom Navigation, Attachment Container, News and Events – RSS, Message Board, New Features, and Resources.





Building Blocks: SmartLinks

URLs to follow via a link, or open within the component (Click or Fetch)










Building Blocks: Collaboration Feed

You can post a snapshot of a dashboard to your Chatter feed to help other users follow changes in information.
