

### Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act (CARES Act)

#### **Higher Education Funding Provisions**

- Total \$31 billion allocated to education
  - \$14 billion for grants to colleges and universities
    - ♦ 90% (\$12.6B) based on Pell grants recipients and total students
    - ♦ 7.5% (\$1B) to tribal colleges and HBCU's
    - ♦ 2.5% (\$0.4B) for schools hit particularly hard by the virus
  - \$3 billion to states for grants to K-12 and higher education, at governor's discretion
  - \$14 billion to K-12



#### **Getting and Spending the Relief Funds**

- \$12.6 billion allocation
  - 75% (\$9.45B) based on the number of full-time equivalent Pell grant recipients
  - 25% (\$3.15B) based on total full-time equivalents
- Funding received
  - 50% must go to students for emergency aid
  - Remainder broad discretion on the use with few explicit exclusions
- Distribution is expected (currently) through G5 draws

#### Possible Distribution of \$12.6B Based on Pell **Recipients\***

\$28.2B\*\* in Pell Grants in 18-19

\$335,000 needs to go to students

School with \$2M in Pell Grants = 0.01% of Total

> \$9.45B = 75% of the \$12.6B


